Terms and Conditions

All observers are welcome, but anyone under the age of sixteen (observing or participating) will require parental accompaniment

Participants 13yr and Under

Must be accompanied by an adult

Must have Signed Parental Consent

Must have passed a competence test at Jugglez

Participants 13 – 16yrs

Must have Signed Parental Consent

Must have passed a competence test at Jugglez

Participants 17yrs and Above

Must have Signed Consent Forms

Must have passed a competence test at Jugglez

Participation at Jugglez Fireclub is granted through application only.

Participants must pass a competence test in their chosen skill; this will be carried out at Jugglez with normal equipment.

participants must sign to say they understand and abide by the terms and conditions.

The safety rules will be followed by all participants with instant expulsion for any who chose not to follow them.

Misbehaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances, as safety is our main concern.

Safety Rules for Jugglez Fireclub

These **MUST** be read and understood – If you have any questions - ask.

You **Must** have listened to, understood and **learnt all Safety rules**. There will be a safety talk given at the beginning of each fire night which you **Must** attend.

Suitable clothing **Must** be worn. **No synthetic clothing** will be allowed as this melts. Denim and cotton are preferable. Sensible garments (**no frills, tassels or baggy flares**) and sturdy footwear are advised. Don't wear your best.

Long hair **must** be bound back or under a hat.

All equipment brought to Jugglez fireclub will be checked rigorously **before** being allowed to be used.

You **Must** be **fully aware** of yourself, the surroundings and other participants **At All Times** when you are playing.

Participants **must be aware** At All Times of the refuelling, equipment and **safety points**.

There will be **No Smoking** near any refuelling or equipment points.

No running, tomfoolery or general larking about **near the designated fire area**.

*Those who play with fire will get burned! (mummy told you and now you'll learn)
and they also get very mossy and smelly.*

Baby wipes are a good way to clean yourself and your equipment before leaving the venue.
